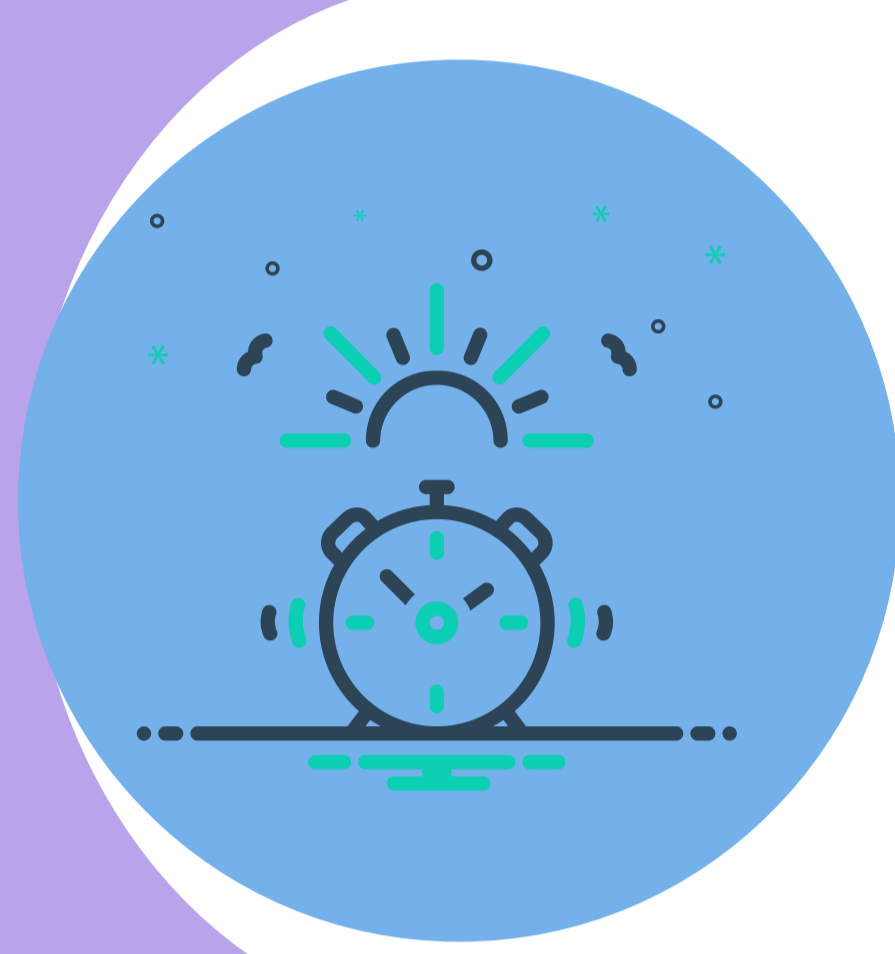


# Rita Moreno's Brother

- Rita discovered she had a brother at the age of seven when her mother brought Francisco to visit.



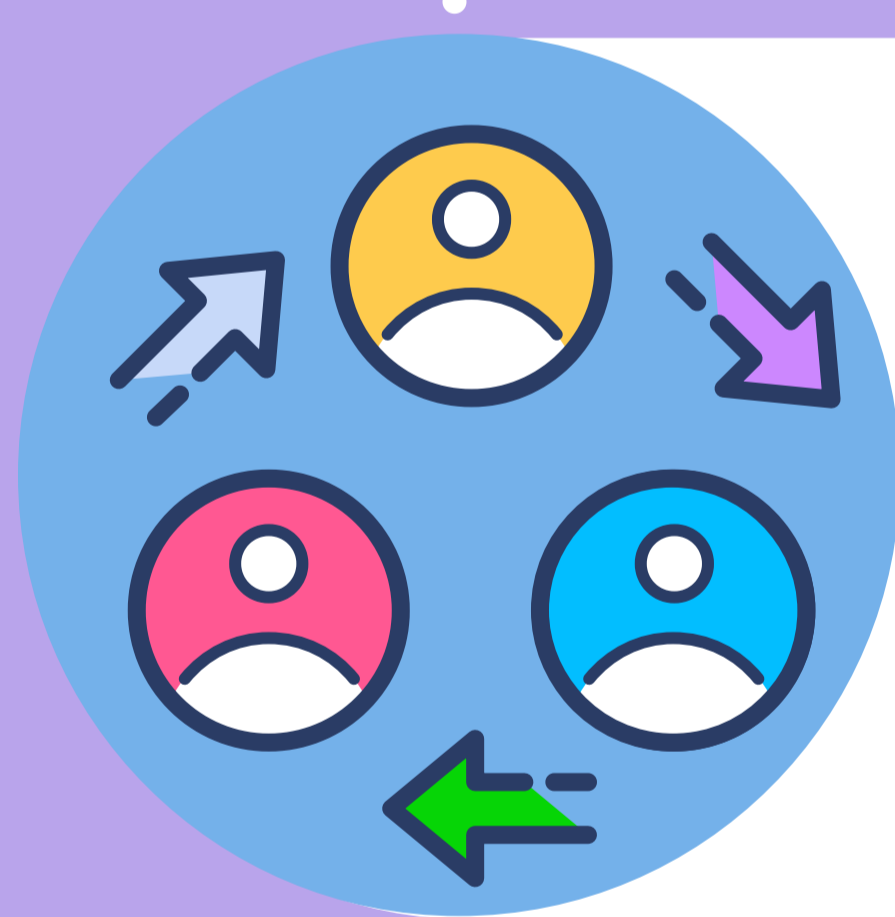
### Career Paths
